SOME NUMBERS

AMC Online continues to grow but at today's launch it already incorporates:

- 21,000** Works from the AMC's collection, including a huge range of diverse material, for example:
 - 2,600 works for piano
 - 1,374 works for orchestra
 - 145 operas, and
 - over 400 radiophonic and electroacoustic works from the ABC's landmark 'Listening Room' program.
- 530** Biographies of Australian composers, improvisers and sound artists, including samples of representative works, mentions of relationships with other artists (including 'influenced by' and 'taught by'), and links to all works, products and related articles.
- 700** Program notes, YouTube videos and newspaper articles.
- 34** Guided tours of major works, people and themes in the history of Australian music including:
 - 7** Timeline overviews of Australian composition and experimental music spanning decades from pre WWII to today
 - 9** Overviews of themes and influences in Australian music including: Asian influences, environmental influences, Indigenous influences, landscape influences, literary influences, pop music influences, spirituality and religious music, visual art influences and women composers.
 - 10** Instrumental music overviews including: bass clarinet, cello, clarinet, flute, harp, oboe, percussion, piano, recorder and viola.

FEATURES OF AMC ONLINE

An Advanced Repertoire Navigator

AMC Online's Advanced Repertoire Navigator offers a step by step process for users to:

- Browse desired instrumentation from a broad range of repertoire areas (eg. band music, jazz ensembles, choral music, orchestral music, dramatic music) and, if desired, by sub-category down to over 1,600 specific instrumental combinations (eg. oboe and harp duos with pre-recorded sound)
- Browse by categories including:
 - Musical forms (eg. symphonies, suites, marches, sonatas, improvisations ...)
 - Style and genre (eg. occasional music, spiritual and sacred music; cross-artform influences ...)
 - Themes and subjects (eg. landscape & nature; visual art influences; Indigenous culture; anti-war; Australian identity ...)
 - Cultures and traditions (eg. Japanese culture; Chinese culture ...)
 - Places (eg. Oceania, Asia ...)
- Find all matching works by difficulty – beginners, intermediate and advanced
- Specify duration and year of composition
- Listen to and view samples of matching works
- Find all available audio samples and score samples
- Find all recordings and scores available for purchase.
